3. If, to sell any immovable property or any part thereof or give on lease any property or any part of parts thereof not required for carrying out the objects of the Trusts, subject however to the permission of President in future.

The number of Trustees shall be not less than three. In the event of any trustee ceasing to be a Trustee by reason of death resignation or physical or mental incapacity or otherwise, the president of the Trust shall have power to appoint or to remove any other person in his place as trustees by giving 48 hours notice, the Trustees cannot approach any court of law.

Trust may make an application for seeking prior permission from government under the foreign contribution (regulation) act, 1976 for the acceptance of foreign contributions by the trust and make an application for seeking registration with the central government under the foreign contribution (regulation) act, 1976 or the acceptance of foreign contribution by the trust.

The Trustees shall not be entitled to any remuneration or to pay any remuneration to any person acting as Trustee out of the Trust Fund.

The trustees shall keep and maintain proper and regular accounts of the Trust Fund and of the income and expenditure and shall get the accounts audited annual Balance sheet and the Income and Expenditure accounts or receipts and payment accounts shall be finally approved and passed by the President and general secretary their ordinary meetings and shall be filled with any, All the audited statements of accounts of the Trust namely the balance sheet and receipt and expenditure account shall also be placed before the meeting of the Trustees for approval.

All accounts in the Banks shall be maintained in the name of the Trust and will be operated by the president of the Trust.

The trustees shall maintain a register of the Trust Fund and its investments and shall keep it up to date by making additions to or alternation in the same as and when new investments are purchased or acquired or disposed of by the Trustees. The Trustees shall physically verify the list or register at least once a year.

The Trustees will have following additional powers

- a) If, to sanction recurring expenses from month to month in future.
- b) If, to sanction expenditure on non recurring its items in any year in future.
- c) If, to invest dispose of transfer or otherwise deal with the funds of the trust subject to the provisions of President to that effect in such manner as the Trustee shall deem fit so as to enable them to carry out the objectives of the trust effectively in future.
- d) And generally to do any other acts or act not mentioned above that may be necessary in the discharge of their duties and execution of the powers vested in the President.
